



ABOUT SIGNING OUR PETITION

Your signature indicates that you have a **MEANINGFUL INTEREST** in having your child/ren attend ISLA in its first year of operation (Fall 2018).

You will likely be contacted to confirm that you have indeed signed the petition. You may also be asked how you can be sure that you are meaningfully interested in a school when so much is still unknown, eg. you don't know who the principal or teachers will be, or where ISLA will be located.

In your response to questions such as these, you may consider the following:

- ISLA's program is based on elementary and middle school programs that have proven to be highly successful, and are designed to be sustainable.
- ISLA's development team is made up of experts in education, linguistics, finance and law, who are also passionate parents who have experienced dual-language immersion first-hand.
- ISLA has the support of a charter services provider with a proven track record of success, and over a decade of experience in supporting dual language programs.
- The ISLA team has already seen a petition through to approval, and despite the disappointment of losing the facility we had been working with, we have persisted in pursuing the dream of opening ISLA.
- Principal/faculty: ISLA has already received a large number of applications for our principal and teacher positions. If our petition is approved, we will move forward with the hiring process, which includes input from our stakeholders.
- Location: While securing a facility is a challenge for all charter schools, our petition to LAUSD offers us a large real-estate market in which to look (our goal is to find a location in north-east Los Angeles). We also continue to have the advantage of working with a major organization which has committed to financing a facility for ISLA.
- Because of the challenge of finding a facility, we also plan to request space from LAUSD under Prop. 39 (which allows charter schools to be given unused space in public schools). In order to facilitate the process, in addition to signing the petition, we ask that you fill out the necessary for form to support our Prop. 39 request. This is not our preferred facility option, but one we will explore to bridge us to our permanent home.
